Jean Michel Lobet, a Senior Financial Markets Specialist, joined the World Bank Group in October 2006. He most recently was a Senior Private Sector Development Specialist with the Doing Business team (a World Bank Group annual flagship report). During his time at the Bank, Mr. Lobet led the research on indicators for protecting investors (the corporate governance indicators of the Doing Business report), co-authored the 2009-2014 editions of the Doing Business report, managed investment climate reform programs in Africa and Latin America, and advised governments on how to improve regulatory aspects of corporate governance through company and securities law reform initiatives.

In addition, he has led training programs and workshops on investment climate and corporate governance issues around the globe, including in Colombia, Brunei Darussalam, United Arab Emirates, Poland, Rwanda, and the Dominican Republic. Before joining the World Bank Group, he held positions related to regulatory reform at the Inter-American Development Bank and the Organization of American States. Mr. Lobet holds a Law degree from Montpellier I University and a Master's degree in International Public Administration from Panthéon-Assas University.
