

## BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

### Leda Condoyanni



Leda Condoyanni is currently the General Director for the Hellenic Corporate Governance Council (HCGC). Her 22 year professional development is composed of 15 years in asset management and financial products, and seven years in direct investment advisory, public administration, public policy and corporate governance. As Adviser to the Hellenic Federation of Enterprises (SEV) on Corporate Governance (CG) she is responsible for the Code on CG and liaises with the Athens Exchange for this matter.

Prior to this as Department Coordinator for State Relations and Institutional Authorities with SEV, she managed the areas of finance, corporate affairs, corporate governance, taxation, public administration, consumer and competition issues, free movement of services and internal market, among others. From 2004-2007, she held the position of Special Adviser to the Chairman of the Board of the Hellenic Centre for Investment (ELKE), the official investment promotion agency of Greece. During a significant part of her career, 1989-2004, she held senior management positions in institutional fund management in the banking and financial services sector, which included Alpha Bank, ETEBA and Ionian Bank.

She has been on the Board of Directors of the Athens Derivatives Exchange (..). In addition, she served on several government committees: the Ministry of Employment, drafting guidelines for pension fund management, the Ministry of Finance, evaluating investment petitions and the Ministry of Interior, for the simplification of administrative processes and better regulation. Ms. Condoyanni was also a Senior Instructor of Finance at Deree College, Athens, for 10 years. She has published articles in academic journals and in the Greek media. Leda Condoyanni received her Ph.D. in Finance in 1989 and her M.A. in Accounting and Finance in 1985, both from the University of Lancaster, UK.
