Simos Anastasopoulos is a graduate of the Department of Electrical Engineering of the National Technical University of Athens (NTUA), and holds a Master's of Science Degree in Mechanical/Automotive Engineering from the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor.

After his studies in Michigan he worked for two years for General Motors Corporation, as a development Engineer at the Milford Proving Ground. He held various positions, initially in the Plastics Raw Materials Department and Textile Dyestuffs Department, and later in the Pharmaceutical Department. In 1993 he was appointed Deputy General Manager, and from this position he assisted in modernizing the manufacturing facilities and expanding the company's operations into the OTC market. Since 2002 he has been the Managing Director and General Manager of the company, and from 2013 Chairman and CEO of PETSIAVAS S.A.
