

PRESS RELEASE

A consortium comprising J&P-AVAX SA and Hitachi Power Europe signed a contract for the construction of a power plant at Vasilikon in Cyprus, with a total budget of €154.9 million.

The project pertains to the construction of a 220 MW power plant in two phases, the first of which involves the installation of two gas turbines with a total power of 150 MW within 22 months, whereas the second phase involves the installation of an additional 70 MW in the next 8 months.

The new power plant will comprise two 6FA+E General Electric gas turbines putting out 75 MW each, plus a 70 MW turbine utilising the exhaust of the two gas turbines, making use of either diesel fuel or natural gas, which is not expected to be phased in before 2010.
