Semi – Annual Review of FTSE/ATHEX Index Series

FTSE/ATHEX Index Series Advisory Committee endorsed today the following changes in the composition of the FTSE/ATHEX Index Series, taking into consideration the results of the semi-annual review for the period November 2016 - April 2017.

In detail the changes:

FTSE/ATHEX Large Cap

One (1) addition, one (1) deletion and three (3) investability weight change.

• FTSE/ATHEX Large Cap Net Total Return

One (1) addition, one (1) deletion and three (3) investability weight change.

FTSE/ATHEX Mid Cap Index

Ten (10) additions, four (4) deletions and one (1) investability weight change.

FTSE/ATHEX – CSE Banking Index

Zero (0) additions, zero (0) deletions and zero (0) investability weight change.

FTSE/ATHEX Market Index

Eleven (11) additions, four (4) deletions and four (4) investability weight change

• FTSE/ATHEX Sector Indices

All changes in the composition of FTSE/ATHEX Market Index will be applied in the composition of the relevant FTSE/ATHEX Sector Indices.

• FTSE/ATHEX Global Traders Index

Three (3) additions, two (2) deletions and four (4) investability weight changes.

• FTSE/ATHEX Global Traders Index Plus

One (1) addition, one (1) deletion and two (2) investability weight changes.



• FTSE/ATHEX Mid & Small Cap Factor Weight Index

Nine (9) additions, nine (9) deletions and zero (0) investability weight changes.
