Tuesday, March 27th, 2018

Commencement of trading of the shares of "<u>ALPHA TRUST MUTUAL FUND AND ALTERNATIVE INVESTMENT FUND MANAGEMENT S.A.</u>" (ISIN:GRS504003021) with new par value of €0.30 per share and ex-rights trading for the entitlement to the capital return of €0.70 per share, as part of the decrease in the par value of the shares of the company. The record date for the aforementioned corporate action is Wednesday, March 28th, 2018.
