- 1. Through the participants in the DSS (Banks and Brokerage/Securities Companies), according to the provisions of the DSS Operation Regulation of the Hellenic Central Securities Depository (ATHEXCSD).
- 2. Especially in cases of payment of the dividend and of part of previous years' retained earnings to the legal heirs of deceased entitled shareholders, whose securities are kept in the Special Account of their S.A.T. ID in the DSS under ATHEXCSD custody, the disbursement process will be facilitated, following completion of the inheritance procedural steps, through any branch of the Alpha Bank network.

The amounts that will not be collected within a five (5) year period will be irrevocably reimbursed to the Greek State.
